

MEMORIAL PARK CHURCH IS SEEKING A CHILDCARE WORKER

Purpose

To assist parents as they invite their children to learn to Love People. Know Jesus. Live Transformed.

Qualifications

- A minimum of a High School Diploma required, further early childhood education experience or certifications desirable.
- An affirming faith in Jesus Christ and experience in ministering to children.

Accountability

- The Childcare Worker will report to the Nursery Coordinator.
- The Childcare Worker shall work collegially with the Nursery Coordinator and other volunteers, providing a safe and nurturing environment for children and their families.

Position Status

This is an "as needed position," primarily 2-3 hours per shift.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Provide childcare in a safe and nurturing environment for infants and toddlers during the various Church wide ministries including Tuesday morning MOPS, Wednesday Morning Women to Women, Wednesday evening Re|Engage Marriage Ministry, Saturday special events, and Sunday special events.
- Nurture children's spiritual development by demonstrating prayer before snack, incorporating music and stories to grow their faith and wonder of God's creation.
- Work with Nursery Coordinator to provide practical and developmentally appropriate activities and crafts for children ages newborn-5.
- Clean linens and toys after each use.
- Rotate toys on a regular basis. Replace and/or repair broken or worn-out equipment.

Personal Characteristics

- Passionate about teaching children about Christ and truly desirous of coming alongside parents through loving and caring for their children.
- Patient with children of all ages and abilities; enthusiastic in trying different behavioral and teaching approaches.
- Lead by Godly example to children and other coworkers; displays the Fruit of the Spirit in working with children: love, joy ,peace, patience, kindness, gentleness, goodness, and self-control.
- A gentle leader, not harsh, with the end goal of leading children in the way of the Lord.
