- Ability to express an evangelical, reformed and missional world-view with children.
- Agrees with the Mission, Vision and Bylaws of Memorial Park Church

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Facilitates the development and implementation of developmentally appropriate curriculum, reflecting current educational philosophies and technology as is age appropriate.
- Establishes academic goals and learning plans for age level, employing measurable tools for evaluating student progress.
- Communicates with parents through a number of sources including email and other online applications.
- Provides Fall and Spring conferences with parents.
- Assists in assessing kindergarten readiness.
- Provides support through the sharing of parenting resources including weekly or monthly newsletters.
- Demonstrates proficiency with basic computer skills including Word, Email, Internet Applications as well as MPC Connect as the primary database and communication tool.

- Participates in beginning and end of the year orientations and celebrations for staff, parents and students.
- Encourages participation in the life of the church (Be supportive and encouraging families to participate in activities and events offered by MPC such as Summer Surge or Family Fun Nights)
