Purpose

Qualifications

- A strong faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord
- A "people friendly" and caring personality
- Ability to work well as part of a ministry team
- Strong background including:
 - o Experience in ministry related to member care in a growing digital environment
 - Experience in the supervision of staff and volunteers
 - o Experience in teaching and preaching, especially memorial services
 - Experience in a large church
- Masters of Divinity/Ordination or ordainable in the EPC

Accountability

- The Pastor of Congregational Care (PCC) shall report directly to the Lead Pastor
- The PCC shall work with the Lead Pastor and the Board of Deacons to oversee and implement all aspects of pastoral care at Memorial Park Church

Position Status

This is a full-time, ordained position with benefits as stipulated by the EPC and MPC's Personnel Handbook.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

Primary Responsibilities

- Provide pastoral care and pastoral counseling to Memorial Park members and friends, in person and online
- Act as the point of contact among Memorial Park pastors for care and digital ministries
- Grow and lead our online experience

Online Church

- Host, connect, and follow up with online congregants and visitors
- Work towards improving the online guest experience
- Connecting an online experience into an in-person experience, bringing individuals into the life of the church
- Creating avenues for prayer and participation in service

Membership

- Assist in maintaining the member and friend records/notes in MPC Connect (our online church directory)
- Co-lead membership classes quarterly
- Track incoming and outgoing members



Essential Duties & Responsibilities Continued

Congregational and Senior Care

- Supervise the Pastoral Associate and support ministries through providing home and nursing home visitation, and coordinating/conducting nursing home worship services
- Regularly visit Memorial Park members in area hospitals and coordinate the Pastoral Care Team to assist with hospital visitation
- Connect our homebound friends to our online services

Other Pastoral Responsibilities

- Regularly lead in worship; administer sacraments; and preach periodically
- Officiate memorials, weddings, and other services, sharing the responsibilities with the pastoral staff
- Serve as a member of Memorial Park's Session, Leadership, and Executive Teams, attending all related staff meetings and Presbytery meetings as needed
- Take time for study, reflection, and rest to nurture spiritual growth and health
