Sunday, September 20

Divine Call

Read 1 Corinthians 1:10. Our Lord calls us to live in harmony with one another. Pray that the PNC members would be of one mind, united in thought and purpose, while we dedicate ourselves as the Lord's instruments to identify MPC's next senior pastor. Pray for the pastor, whom the Lord has anointed to serve MPC, to clearly recognize that the Lord is calling him to our congregation.

Monday, September 21

Guidance

Read Psalm 119:105. Jesus is the light in the midst of the dark world in which we live. His light provides guidance for us as we walk with Him. Ask the Lord to illuminate the person to the PNC that He has called to be MPC's next senior pastor, even before the beginning of time. Let us all shine His light for the world to see His Spirit in us!

Tuesday, September 22

God's Promises

Read Romans 4:13. God makes promises to His people and is always faithful in keeping those promises. We must live out a right relationship with God by remaining faithful to abide in Christ and constantly seeking to do His will. Pray that the PNC would be reminded that God is sovereign and promises to never leave us or forsake us, even when times may become difficult or challenging.

Wednesday, September 23

God's Blessing

Read Psalm 23:6. What a blessing to know that the Lord's goodness and unfailing love will pursue us all the days of our lives! When we follow Him, we are abundantly blessed with His mighty riches—the Holy Spirit, His glorious grace and unending mercy, His unconditional love, eternal life, and spiritual gifts. In partnership with the PNC, praise the Lord that He will sustain us with all that we need during the search for the next senior pastor. God is good, all the time, especially today!

Thursday, September 24

Covenant

Read Hebrews 12:24. The salvation of Jesus is the new covenant between God and people. Thank and praise our heavenly Father for such an awesome gift. Pray that the PNC would proclaim Jesus' name to move us through the search process with wisdom and discernment. There is power in the name of Jesus!

Friday, September 25

Obedience

Read Psalm 46:10. Be still in His presence. Listen for His voice. Obey His words. As the members of the PNC practice stillness in God's presence and listen for His voice to reveal whom he has chosen as our next senior pastor, please pray that we would be obedient to the Spirit's leading. Pray that the PNC is unanimous in our agreement of who God is calling to shepherd MPC.
