Sunday, January 10

Divine Call

Read Matthew 24:36. The Almighty wants us occupied with His agenda until He returns. As Kingdom builders for Christ, we pray each day for guidance on how and where He wants us to place our bricks of belief for His glory. We pray, especially in the season, for a senior pastor who preaches the Gospel and shepherds with a sense of urgency.

Monday, January 11

Guidance

Tuesday, January 12

God's Promises

Read Nehemiah 9:8. The Lord is faithful. He fulfills His promises for those who are faithful and even through those who are not. In this 80th year of MPC's story, we praise God for what he has done and what He is doing.

Wednesday, January 13

God's Blessings

Read Psalm 1:3. Blessing looks for those who are in a position of dependency on Almighty God. When we take the time to plant our faith by the banks of God's living water, we come alive. The blessing of God's fruit comes when we cling to the counsel of Christ and His followers.

Thursday, January 14

God's Covenant

Read Deuteronomy 7:9. During a time in which many things around us seem uncertain and unstable, we must cling afresh to the steadfast and unshakable love of God for his creation. May he hear our prayers and establish the work of our hands and through us shine forth his steadfast love.

Friday, January 15

Obedience

Read Psalm 119:1-3. The integrity of following the Lord's instructions is the joyful path of God's will. When our work is purposeful, we discover joy in making a difference. Lord, help us to remain obedient to your will.

Saturday, January 16

Prayerful

Read Daniel 9:21-23. Our Lord Jesus smiles when we take the time to save time by waiting on His understanding in prayer. Please pray for the PNC and their families. For every aspect of health—be it physical, emotional, relational, mental, and spiritual. Pray for God's divine protection, all in His precious name. Amen.
