

Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) Prayer Guide April 25-May 1, 2021

“The prayer of the righteous is powerful and effective” (James 5: 16, *NIV*)

God is Jehova-jireh

This name means “the God who provides.” Just as He provided yesterday, He will also provide today and tomorrow.

Sunday, April 25

Read Genesis 22:2. What are we willing to sacrifice to serve the Lord? Is it our time? Finances? What about our independence? Just as we know God is unchanging, He is also a provider. There is nothing that He needs from us, so it is up to us to decide to offer Him our time, our finances, our independence, and our trust!

Monday, April 26

Read Matthew 6:26-34. As God provides for the plants and animals in nature, He also knows and will provide for our every need. Our responsibility is to give all of our desires to Him. Suppose we focus our thoughts on His kingdom and what we can individually and corporately do to reach souls for Christ. Then all our desires will come in their appointed time, including a lead pastor.

Tuesday, April 27

Read Psalm 23. Shelter, protection, nourishment, and guidance. These are a few of the things David uses to remind us of the Lord's provision. Pray with the PNC that we find comfort in the Lord's staff while we continue to follow His will.

Wednesday, April 28

Read Luke 12:31. Because we know the Lord provides for our needs, our focus and attention should be on doing the work He has called each of us to. For some it may be praying and offering words of encouragement for others.

Thursday, April 29

Read Luke 9:13. Sometimes we find ourselves in situations where it seems like we lack the Lord's provision. The resources right in front of us look like they are limited, without suitable capacity. However, with God all things are possible, and he has been faithful to provide what we need at the appointed time.

Friday, April 30

Read Psalm 147:6. Jesus led by example in his surrender and obedience to God. Being imperfect beings, unlike Jesus, we should pray continually that the Lord would refine our hearts and continuously draw us closer to him through His Bible.

Saturday, May 1

Read Matthew 27:50-52. Jesus was the ultimate provision for our salvation. Please pray for the PNC and their families. For every aspect of health—be it physical, emotional, relational, mental, and spiritual. Pray for God's divine protection, all in His precious name. Amen.
